


Windows Mail(Vista) and Windows Live Mail POP Acct. IMAP settings are listed below

Open Windows Mail.

Click the **Tools** menu, and select **Accounts...**

Click the Mail tab, select your POP account and click **Properties**.

(For Windows Live Mail, click the Accounts tab, then the Server tab)

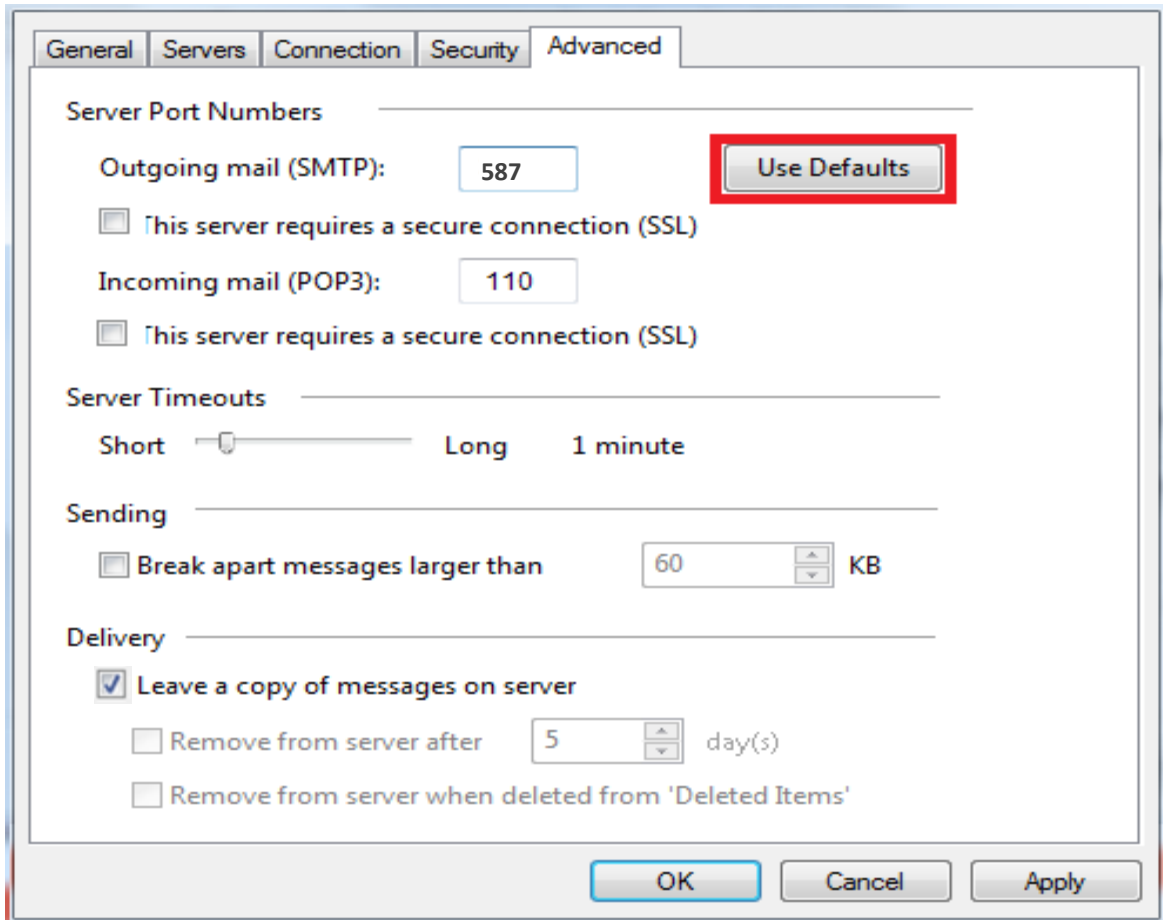
Click on the **Servers** Tab and change the following fields:

POP server: mail.bnin.net

SMTP server: mail.bnin.net

Verify the box next to **My server requires authentication** is checked.

Click the **Advanced** tab and Click the **Use Defaults** button.



Verify that the settings were reset to the following:

Outgoing mail (SMTP): 587 (This server requires a secure connection (SSL) should NOT be checked)

Incoming mail (POP3): 110 (This server requires a secure connection (SSL) should NOT be checked)

Click **OK**.

Outgoing Mail: 587
